

Long Course Open Invitational

Hosted By: Jenison Area Wildcat Swimming

Saturday, May 28, 2016

Sanction - This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc. (MS), as a timed final meet on behalf of USA Swimming (USA-S), Sanction Number **MI1516108**. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. MS rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as is fully set forth in these meet rules.

Location – Jenison High School Aquatics Center 2140 Bauer Rd. Jenison, MI 49426

Times - Saturday Morning

Warm up Starts: 8:00am Check in Closes: 8:15am Events Begin: 9:00am

Saturday Afternoon

Warm up Starts: Immediately following the morning session, but not before 12:00pm.

Check in Closes: 15 minutes after warm up begins.

Events Begin: One hour after warm up begins.

Facilities – The Jenison High School Aquatics Center is an eight lane 50 meter pool. Lanes 2 through 8 will be used for competition and lane 1 will be available for supervised warm-up and warm-down. Depth at start is 13'11 and 4'6" at the turn. Movable starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. IST timing with a seven lane display will be used. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). The Competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

Eligibility – The 2016 JAWS First Chance Meet is open to all level of swimmers with no entry time qualifications. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States of American Swimming (USA-S). A swimmer's age on Saturday, May 28, 2016, will determine his or her eligibility for a particular age group.

Deck Registration - Unregistered swimmers must register on deck at this meet by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Referee. The cost of registering on deck is double the normal fee (\$140.00 per swimmer for 2016 registration).

Meet Format - This meet is an open invitational, timed finals meet with 13 & over swimmers in the AM and 12 & under swimmers in the PM.

Entry Limits - Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis by date of email for electronic entries and date of receipt by the Administrative Official for hard copy entries until the Michigan Swimming Four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. As set forth in entry procedures below, (A) a hard copy of your club's entry summary sheet, (B) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (C) your club's certification of entered athletes and (D) your club's entry and entry fees must be received by the Entry Chair in a timely fashion prior to the start of the meet, or your swimmers will not be allowed

to swim in the meet. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned even if received before the entry deadline.

Swimmers Without A Coach - Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach, must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Individual Entry Limits – All swimmers may enter up to four (4) events.

Electronic Entries - \$5.00 per individual event. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: JAWS.

Paper Entries - MS rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. \$6.00 per individual event. There is a \$1.00 additional charge per individual event if the entry is not submitted in Hy-Tek format. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge for each swimmer also applies to paper entries. Paper entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official on a spreadsheet of your choice; however, the paper entry must be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the Administrative Official to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times.

Entry Procedures - Entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official as of Saturday, April 30, 2016, at 8:00pm. The Administrative Official must receive all entries no later than Saturday, May 21, 2016, at 8:00pm. Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (http://www.miswim.org/). All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail to the Administrative Official at bperisao@gmail.com. All entries will be processed in order by email date code or mail date code. Any entries submitted will be considered provisional until such time as the Administrative Official has received a hard copy of: (a) your club's entries (Team Manager Meet Entries Report), (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your clubs signed certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry fees. This must be received in a timely fashion prior to the start of the meet or your swimmers will not be allowed to swim in the meet. Refunds - Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part.

*Entry fees and paperwork may be delivered to Betty Peristeridis at the main computer in the Jenison HS pool office on Saturday, May 28. Please let Betty know that you will turn in your paperwork and payment at the meet if you choose to go that route.

Check In - Check In will be available 30 minutes prior to the beginning of warm up. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from all events in that session. Check in will close 15 minutes after the start of warm up for each session. Check in sheets will be separated by gender and located on a table outside of each respective locker room on the pool deck.

Scratch Rules - Prior to check in closing a swimmer may scratch events on the appropriate check in sheets. After check in closes, yo

u must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event.

Marshalling - There is no marshaling in this meet. Heat sheets will be posted for self-marshaling for all age groups underneath the American flag and the scoreboard.

Seeding - Seeding will be done after check in closes. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event.

All events will be seeded slowest to fastest after check in closes.

Deck Entries/Time Trials - Deck entries will be accepted if space and time allow. Time trials will not be offered. The deck entry fee is \$7.50 per individual event. Deck entry swimmers are subject to the Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge if they are not already in the meet. For deck entries, registration status must be proven by providing a current USA Swimming membership card or a current print out of an athlete roster from the Club Portal, the Club Portal is located on the USA Swimming website. The athlete may also enter by showing their membership from USA Swimming's DECK PASS on a smart phone. The swimmer may compete unattached (UN) if they request to do so.

Meet Program/Admissions - Admission is \$5.00. Children 8 & under are free with a paying adult. Heat sheets will be available for \$2.00 at the admissions and/or concessions table after they are announced as available.

Scoring - No scores will be kept.

Awards – 1^{st} through 8^{th} place ribbons will be awarded to 8 & Under, 9 & 10, and 11 & 12 age groups. There are no awards for 13 & Overs. Coaches must claim awards at the end of the meet. They will not be mailed.

Results - Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at http://www.miswim.org/. Unofficial results will be emailed out to all entry chairs that submitted entries for the 2016 JAWS First Chance Meet immediately following the meet.

Concessions - Food and beverages will be available in the upstairs balcony. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

Lost and Found - Articles may be turned in/picked up at the pool office. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Swimming Safety - Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down lane. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing - Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The General Chair of MS and the Program Operations Vice-Chair of MS are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

Lists of registered coaches, certified officials and meet personnel will be placed outside the hallway door to the locker rooms/pool deck. Meet personnel will check the list of approved individuals and issue a credential to be displayed at all times during the meet. This credential will include the JAWS logo as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date

of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities - All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

General Info - Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.

First Aid - Supplies will be kept in pool office and on deck with the lifequards on duty.

Facility Items -

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of the Jenison High School Aquatics Center
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers must have shoes to go into the hallway, to the lobby, to the balcony, and to the concession stand.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by JAWS to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection in the pool office.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than our locker rooms or bathrooms is prohibited.
- (G) Outside food items are not allowed in the pool balcony.
- (H) Only medically necessary chairs are allowed in the pool balcony.

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Michigan Swimming Clubs must register and pay for the registration of all athletes that are contained in the electronic TM Entry File or any paper entries that are submitted to the Meet Host with the Office of Michigan Swimming prior to submitting the meet entry to the meet host. Clubs from other LSCs must register and pay for the registration of their athletes with their respective LSC Membership Coordinator.

A penalty fee of \$100.00 per unregistered athlete will be levied against any Club found to have entered an athlete in a meet without first registering the athlete and paying for that registration with the Office of Michigan Swimming or their respective LSC Membership Coordinator.

Submitting a meet entry without the athlete being registered and that registration paid for beforehand may also subject the Club to appropriate Board of Review sanctions.
