**July 14-15, 2026**

In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Inc. and Michigan Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. MS rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.

## Facilities

**Northview High School**, is a 10 lane pool with a supervised warm-up and warm down area available. Eight lanes will be used for competition. Depth at start is 7'6"<sup>1</sup> and 7'6" at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Colorado timing system with a(n) 10 lane display will be used.

**Byron Center High School**, is an 8 lane pool with a supervised warm-up and warm down area available. Eight lanes will be used for competition. Depth at start is 6'6"<sup>2</sup> and 3'6" at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Colorado timing system with an 8 lane display will be used.

## Course Certification

The competition courses have not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)

## Meet Format

The WMSL Summer A Championship is an age group meet where swimmers are separated into the following age groups: 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & Over. 12 & Under swimmers will swim on Tuesday and 13 & Over swimmers will swim on Wednesday.

## Eligibility

All athletes are eligible to participate in this meet that have participated in an approved WMSL meet after April 1, 2026. Athletes must also meet the qualifying time as required.

## Entry Procedures

Entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official as of **June 25, 2026 @ 12:00pm**. The Administrative Official must receive all entries no later than **July 10, 2026 @ 3:00pm**. Entries for USA registered athletes must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail at the e-mail address listed in the last section of this meet information packet.

## Entry Acceptance and Processing

Entries will be accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis in the order in which they are received after the entry open date listed above.

## Individual Entry Limits

Swimmers may be entered in up to 2 individual events and 2 relay events, but not more than 4 total.

Teams are limited to an A and B relay for each relay event. Both A and B relays are limited to 2 relay only swimmers for each relay event. All B relays will swim exhibition.

12 & under swimmers must meet the WMSL A qualifying time to enter the A meet. No qualifying times for 13 & Over.

Swimmers with only one qualifying time can enter 1 bonus event.

## Entry Fees

There are no entry fees for this meet.

## **Surcharges**

A \$1.00 per athlete Michigan Swimming athlete surcharge applies. WMSL will cover the surcharge.

## **Refunds**

Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the Administrative Official there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules).

## **Check In**

Check-in will be required. It will be available 30 minutes prior to the start of warm up. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from all events in the session. Check-in will close 15 minutes after the start of warm up. Check-in sheets for the Tuesday session will be posted outside the pool. Check-in sheets for the Wednesday session will be posted in the lobby near the balcony entrance.

## **Marshaling**

There is no marshaling in this meet. Heat sheets will be posted around the pool after check-in closes and seeding is complete.

## **Seeding**

Seeding will be done after check in closes. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event. All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest.

## **Deck Entries**

Deck entries will **not** be allowed.

## **Meet Programs/Admissions**

The admission fee is \$5.00 per person. Children 10 and under may enter free. Heat sheets will be available at the admissions table for \$2.00 after the meet is seeded.

## **Scoring**

Team Scores will be kept/points will be awarded for the top 16 times as follows:

Individual events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2 (only the A relays will score)

## **Awards**

Medals for individual events and relays 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Ribbons for individual events 4<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> place. Awards will be split into 9-10 and 11-12 categories. There will be no awards for 13 & Over swimmers. All B relays will swim exhibition and are not eligible for awards.

## **Results**

Complete Official meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at <http://www.miswim.org/>. Unofficial results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.

## **Concessions**

Food and beverages will be available in the concession stand. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

## **Lost and Found**

Articles may be turned in/picked up at the pool office. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

## **Swimming Safety**

Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

## **Racing Start Certification**

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

## **Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing**

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck. Only athletes are permitted in the locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The Michigan Swimming Board of Directors, Officials Chairs of MS, and the Michigan Swimming Office staff are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

All individuals seeking access to the pool deck must show a valid digital USA Swimming membership card reflecting good standing in order to receive a deck credential. The credential must be displayed at all times during the meet and will include the host team name as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

### **Swimmers with Disabilities**

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

### **First Aid**

Supplies will be kept in the pool office.

### **Medical Supervision**

Lifeguards and an AED device will be available to all athletes participating in this competition.

### **Facility Items**

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of any facility listed above.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan is available for review and inspection at the pool office.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is **prohibited**.
- (G) Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

### **General Information and Errors/Omissions**

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
